Aicardi voted B.O.D. President; Pearlman re-elected to Board

Bellingham resident Tracy Aicardi gained election as President of the AB-MI-TV Board of Directors in a unanimous vote June 11. Diane Mela Souvanna was voted in as Board Vice-President. Sue Carlson was elected Board Secretary and Jereme Cooper gained reelection as Board Treasurer.

In other business at the June 11 meeting, Station Manager Patrick Fleming said the staff is working on a montage of past Memorial Day Parades as part of the Bellingham 300th Anniversary celebration.

Publicity Director Steve Saraceno distributed packets of scholarship applications to the Board for their consideration. They must pick one winner from Bellingham and one from Mendon for the \$1,000 awards.

In the April 4 meeting of the ABMI Board, Earl Pearlman gained reelection to his Mendon seat.

The vote by the Board was unanimous.





In other news at the April 4 meeting, Pearlman reported that President Nick Russell had recently moved to Florida.

Regarding the Treasurer's Report for Nov. 2018, Treasurer Jereme Cooper asked where the portable camera setups were. Station Manager Patrick Fleming said there are two in Miscoe School.

Publicity Director Steve Saraceno talked about the press conference held by Sen. Markey concerning the proposed FCC actions that threaten the financing of Public Access. Saraceno said he went to the open discussion prior to the press conference, which was attended by over 150 cable access people from across the state.

Fleming said that the new SCALA video bulletin board maintenance budget item rose to \$8,000 in the past year, but that was a "one-off." This year the item will be budgeted at \$4,000.

Fleming said he increased the Volunteer Night budget to \$800.

Fleming increased the budget item for Sports Announcers and Crew Members to \$5,000.
