New Camera Setups Ordered For Mendon and Bellingham

Station Manager Patrick Fleming told the ABMI Board at the Nov. 9 virtual meeting that new cameras had been ordered for both of the robotic setups at the Mendon and Bellingham town halls.

Fleming said there may be a delay due to backups in shipping. He added that he is ordering black cameras instead of white for the Mendon Town Hall. Delivery of the white might have been delayed.

In other business, Fleming said the Treasurer's Report for July 2021 wraps up most of the expenses for renovation of the studio building. There may be a couple more items reported in the August Treasurer's report concerning the kitchen renovation.

Fleming said one of the cameras for Hawk TV will not power up, so he purchased a new camera for the



club. ABMI Production Coordinator Tyler McMinniman said it works "perfect."

Board President Tracy Aicardi asked if a new cleaning crew had been hired for the building. Fleming said there is a different staff now, but it is part of the same company.

Fleming reported that Pete Royce has been announcing some recent high school football games.

Board Treasurer Sue Carlson said she does not recall Bob Carlson ever covering the construction of the Mendon Senior Center back in 1994.

Fleming said McMinniman would be covering meetings in both Bellingham and Mendon on the same night.

Board Secretary Earl Pearlman asked Carlson whether the Mendon Minstrels were presenting a holiday program this year. Carlson said no. She added that masks for the singers cost twenty dollars a piece.

3. DVD copies of ABMI shows are available for \$15.75 per copy. We have shows going back as far as 1985, so if there's a blast from the past you'd like to see again, call us at 508-966-3234.
4. ABMI encourages interested volunteers. Our staff is available to teach basic camera technique and non-linear editing on a one-to-one basis.
