During the Nov. 3 meeting of the ABMI Board of Directors, Board Secretary Earl Pearlman inquired as to whether the station could cover the Veterans Day Breakfast at the Mendon Senior Center Nov. 11.

Production Coordinator Tyler McMinniman asked Pearlman the time of the event. Pearlman said it would take place from 8:30pm to 10:30pm. McMinniman and Station Manager Patrick Fleming said the station would cover the event and cablecast the finished production throughout November.

In other business, Board Vice-President Jereme Cooper asked whether ABMI needed to do anything to prepare for the upcoming conversion to High Definition.



Fleming said that everything on the station's end is ready for the upgrade.

4. ABMI encourages interested volunteers. Our staff is available to teach basic camera technique and non-linear editing on a one-to-one basis.
