

ABMI Puts Archives to Use Now and Then

New Series Highlights Gems from the Past

Up until a few years ago, ABMI-TV daily programming could be seen only in Bellingham and Mendon. Nowadays it is accessible throughout the world at abmi8.org. Not only that, but productions of the recent past can easily be seen again via the Archives tab at the site.

Now ABMI is reaching further back into history. As part of an ongoing project to preserve videotaped shows that date as far back as the station's origins in 1985, Publicity Director Steve Saraceno is producing a retrospective series called *Blast from the Past*.

"There's a lot of interesting stuff we're trying to save," says Saraceno. "It's only in the last twenty years or so that local communities would have such an extensive history of moving images. So as we transfer the tapes from one medium to another, it's important to give people a look at what we have."

ABMI Board of Directors Vote to Approve Purchase of New Studio Monitor and Deck

At the Board of Directors Meeting Jan. 8, Station Manager Patrick Fleming explained the need for a new studio monitor that would free up space for camera movement.

The board unanimously approved the spending of up to \$2500 for the purchase of a flat screen studio monitor, swing arm support, and editing deck.

Fleming said he will notify the board if it looks like the total cost will exceed that figure.

In other business, Board President Jereme Cooper asked about the entry in the Treasurer's Report denoting \$1900 for "Key Signs." Fleming said that covered the cost of labor for the wrap of the production van.

Cooper asked whether things had been straightened out concerning the finalizing of discs at the Bellingham Town Hall. Fleming said he will send Production Coordinator Erik Fischer down there to give further instruction.



Board Member Tracy Aicardi asked about the donations total for the Santa's Elves Telethon. Publicity Director Steve Saraceno said approximately \$5,000 in gifts and monetary pledges came in this holiday season.

Fleming reported that new cameras are needed for the setup at South School. Coverage of school committee meetings is now down to one good camera. Fleming would like to install a two-camera robotic setup. Cooper cautioned against installation of the cameras until it is reasonably certain that the school committee meetings will stay at that site. Fleming said he would wait until he hears from the committee.


Winter productions warm up ABMI studio!

1. You can post free notices for your non-profit organization or activity on our video bulletin board. Best way is to email us at abmi8@comcast.net. You can also phone at 508-966-3234. Or send a fax at 508-966-2321.
2. All our public channel cablecasts stream live at the same time from our website at abmi8.org. Taped public meetings and special events are also available for viewing in the Archive section at our site.
3. DVD copies of ABMI shows are available for \$15.75 per copy. We have shows going back as far as 1985, so if there's a blast from the past you'd like to see again, call us at 508-966-3234.
4. ABMI encourages interested volunteers. Our staff is available to teach basic camera technique and non-linear editing on a one-to-one basis.
5. Station Manager Patrick Fleming, Publicity Director Steve Saraceno, and Production Coordinator Erik Fischer are generally available weekdays by calling 508-966-3234.
6. The ABMI public channel is Channel 8 for Comcast subscribers and Channel 47 for Verizon folks.
